

## Exhorter part 2 Blessings

1. Today I speak these blessings over you, your family, all those on your prayer list, and those on this challenge (Past, Present and Future). We do this in the name of Yeshua HaMashiach - The Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God the Father.
2. I call your human spirit forward to bless the Exhorter portion with these blessings and to remind him or her who they are. May the angels of Almighty God, through the power of the Holy spirit, carry these words to your exhorter, wherever he or she is, and may the full portion of your human spirit, soul and body be rejuvenated and restored back to God's original design.

### **JOY**

3. Exhorter, you have heard the words "I just want to be happy". Yes, you have the right to be happy. It is one of the blessings that comes from the Lord. When you were formed in God's image you were created to be happy, to receive happiness and make others happy. People should be glad and happy when they hear your name, and that you are going to be with them. May God bring you revelation into this matter, and show you the avenues where you need healing, and train you on how to smile again, how to light up a room, how to make people feel special and important. You were meant to change people's lives and make those who meet you glad they did. Even if they only see you for a few seconds, those seconds should leave a lasting impression on their spirit. That smile of yours is so important Exhorter. It tells people you are happy to see them and that they are special. You have noticed them, and they are valuable. There is so much fruit and growth in joy, and I bless you with right thinking regarding joy and its importance in your life. May you go after joy like hidden treasure, because it is the joy of the Lord that brings you strength, regardless of your circumstances – there is joy, if you look deep enough.
4. I bless you Exhorter with the ability to make jokes, to be able to laugh at yourself, and have the creativity to retell people of your mishaps in an amusing way. Joy is a blessing from God, and we are not to take ourselves seriously all the time. God wants you to be able to relax and have fun at the right times. Proverbs 17:22 says A merry heart does good, like medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones. Don't let anyone lie to you and say you don't have a sense of humour. Your humour just needs to be rediscovered. Like a buried treasure, it is there, or it has been stolen and needs to be recaptured. Every person created in God's image was given the gift of joy and the ability to make people laugh and to be able to laugh at oneself. Each person has this to varying degrees, but we all have it. May God restore unto you, the joy of your salvation Ps 51v12. I declare that God will restore your joy and your ability to make jokes. Inside each person God has placed the ability to link up with the fountain of joy in heaven where out of it flows rivers of living water.
5. John 7v38 says "On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. 38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." Exhorter, these rivers flow from the throne room of God and are intended to flow through your throne into the lives of the people you come into contact with. You are God's change agent, bringing joy to people that are in need of a smile, and an encouraging word.

1 Peter 1:8 ... you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory. (This is joy unspeakable). Exhorter, God has an abundance of joy waiting for you.

Psalms 30 I will extol You, O Lord, for You have lifted me up, And have not let my enemies rejoice over me.

2 O Lord my God, I cried out to You, And You healed me.

3 O Lord, You brought my soul up from the grave; You have kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

4 Sing praise to the Lord, you saints of His, and give thanks at the remembrance of His Holy Name.

5 For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for life; Weeping may endure for a night, But joy comes in the morning. But joy comes in the morning.

6. Exhorter, God's word never lies and when He says Joy comes in the morning, then joy comes in the morning. John 16:33 "These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me you might have peace. In the world you shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." Jesus says Be happy, rejoice, it is just a season and you will come through it because He endured, He overcame, and He has given us life, abundant life. He is our healer, our deliverer, our rescuer, our strong tower, our very present help in trouble – and He is everywhere, all the time. He knows what you thinking. He knows when you lie down, and He is always waiting to encourage you, love you and restore you. Come unto me, when you are tired, and I will give you rest. It is He Yeshua Hamashiach, the Lord Jesus Christ – our redeemer.
7. In Him we live and move and have our being. We are not alone. So, rejoice in the Lord always, and again Exhorter – I say rejoice! Joy starts with a choice. You choose to always see the brighter side of things. As you think your emotions will follow. Keep those thoughts focused on the word and He will give you the scriptures to lift you up.
8. I recently learnt that the word of God is a portal. A portal is a door that takes you to the other side. You can take scriptures, Exhorter, and go into them, and find yourself in a whole new realm in the spirit. Repeat after me. Lord Jesus, Yeshua..show me how to use Your Word as a portal...to go into them..Help me to be disciplined to meditate on your word....., to visualize it.... to see it come to pass.... to live inside Your word. Show me how to go into you.. Proverbs 18:10 The name of the Lord is a strong tower: the righteous run into it, and are safe.
9. Exhorter, never give up on Joy. Joy is yours. Joy is your inheritance, now, here on earth. Keep going! His promises are Yes and Amen. That means what He said He will do, He will surely do it. Now remember Exhorter, with restoration comes obedience. The Holy Spirit is going to lead and guide you on the path to find restoration. That means you need to follow instructions no matter how menial, how insignificant, foolish, weird, crazy they may be. Remember you don't always get to decide or determine the way in which your prayers will be answered. Most of the time it comes in the package you least expect. You must be ready to take risks, do things that are out of character, it may make you feel very foolish – but are necessary for your breakthrough.
10. God can even speak to you through a donkey, like He did to Balaam. In Numbers 22 we read how the king of the Moabites was very afraid of the Israelites coming near his land and he called for Balaam to curse them so that he could overthrow them. And he said to Balaam in v6 I know that he whom you bless is blessed, and he whom you curse is

cursed.” Then in verse 12 God had to speak to Balaam and warn him, “You shall not go with them; you shall not curse the people, for they are blessed.”

11. Exhorter, I decree and declare that every person that has sent a curse to you and your family, living and dead – those curses will be cancelled and nullified through the power of the name of Yeshua, Jesus Christ and His blood. We ask for forgiveness for the legal rights given to allow these curses to land. Holy Spirit show us how to make right where needed and restore to us what we have lost as a result of these curses.
12. You are a child of the Most High, whom He has blessed. If God needs to send you a talking donkey to get your attention then so be it. Let the fear of God fall on those who would dare to curse whom God has blessed. Exhorter, I declare and decree that you are blessed, your family is blessed and your future generations till the day that Jesus Christ comes. May Jesus show you how to bring this declaration to pass – for it is a journey to bless time.
13. Balaam didn’t want to listen to God and went with them to curse the Israelites. And his donkey refused to travel any further and Balaam started to hit his donkey. The donkey replied in v28 “What have I done to you, that you have struck me these three times?” “Am I not your donkey on which you have ridden, ever since I became yours, to this day? Did I ever disobey you?” 31 Then the Lord opened Balaam’s eyes, and he saw the Angel of the Lord standing in the way with His drawn sword in His hand; and he bowed his head and fell flat on his face. 32 And the Angel of the Lord said to him, “Why have you struck your donkey these three times? Behold, I have come out to stand against you, because your way is perverse before Me.
14. May the Sword of the Lord, and His mighty angels stand before your Exhorter, to prevent you and your family from taking the wrong path and cursing what God has blessed. May God send His mighty warring angels to search and rescue all parts of you and your family that have been taken into captivity, where the enemy is tormenting your parts, stealing your joy and derailing the plans that God has for you.
15. May God turn your mourning into dancing; remove your ashes and put on you the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. May you not stay silent but sing of His praises and goodness. In the spirit realm may those prison doors fling open, and the shackles break off your feet. Let everything holding you back from your dreams be revealed, and addressed in the Mighty Name of Yeshua Hamashiach, the Lord Jesus Christ.

### **ENJOY YOUR LABOUR**

16. Exhorter, you are to enjoy the labour of your hands. 1 Timothy 5v18 says, “You shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain,” and, “The laborer is worthy of his wages.” Exhorter, take time to enjoy nature, enjoy the trees and hear the sound of the birds. Spend time with nature, it increases your frequency. It makes you more resilient to the germs around you. It improves your health, your mood, your appetite. You feel better when you spend time with nature. God created us to govern over nature and creation and this is done through love, appreciation and relationship.

### **ENTER INTO REST**

17. Exhorter, you also need to take rest, and keep the Sabbath. How to keep the Sabbath? You need to ask the Lord. This is a big challenge in our modern-day life. Exhorter, some would say God did away with the Sabbath. But think logically what it stood for, and then ask yourself, do you really think God did away with something that honored him and brought rest and blessing to His people? The Sabbath is a day to look forward to, to refresh in His presence, to spend time with the family, to refrain from work. How this Sabbath will look will vary for each person. Exhorter, find the discipline to practice this rest as a family. Ask God for His grace in this area.
18. Repeat after me “Lord Jesus, Yeshua, your word says to keep the sabbath.... How do I do this? ....How can I honor you in this? ....How do I spend this time? ...I want to find pleasure in your company... You gave us the 10 commandments, not 9...Help me and my family to carve out time with you and one another.

### **POSTIVE MOTIVATIONAL TALK**

19. I bless you with the ability to lift yourself up, to speak positive motivational words and to encourage yourself. I bless you with Proverbs 24:16 For a righteous man may fall seven times. And rise again, But the wicked shall fall by calamity. Exhorter, though you go through tough times you will arise. You will pull yourself up to face another day. You are not doing it alone. God is with you and is your strength, of whom shall you be afraid. No-one! Learn to spend time in the garden with Yeshua, with Father, and with the Holy Spirit to hear His voice and to share with Him the challenges you are facing. Exhorter, ensure that your body is well and healthy, and rests when needed.

### **MISTAKES**

20. Exhorter, we all make mistakes, and it is okay to make a mistake. The difference is how you behave when you have made a mistake. Exhorter, it is for you to encourage self to own up to your mistakes, say you were wrong, and seek God on how to fix it. Be brave and face the consequences when required. It is better to face the punishment and get it over with, than pushing it down and letting it resurface in future generations. You have heard the saying “No crime goes unpunished”. And that is true, because everything is recorded and everything will be judged if it not placed under the blood of Jesus Yeshua. Either you pay the penalty or your future generations will. Remember Saul he tried to break the covenant with the Gibeonites and it was his sons who died. (2 Samuel 21). Hezekiah received mercy for his sins and got an additional 15 years added to his life but it was his sons who saw the punishment. 2 Kings 20. The devil is like a roaring lion looking for his next victim and he is patient and will wait for the right time to collect. You cannot hide anything. Be like King David who said it was better to fall into the hands of God for his punishment than into the hands of man. 2 Samuel 24v14.
21. Matthew 5:25 Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversary deliver you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison. 26 Assuredly, I say to you, you will by no means get out of there till you have paid the last penny. Exhorter, I bless you with the ability to make right quickly and admit when you are wrong. May God have mercy on you in those times and make those crooked paths straight. Where you are battling with addiction and reoccurring sin, bring it to Jesus again and again and again. Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and He

will guide you to the root causes of why you do what you do. Paul had the same problem, He said what I want to do I don't do and what I do I don't want to do. Romans 7v15.

22. I bless you Exhorter with the courage and boldness you will need each time you fall and each time someone hurts you. I bless you with the ability to say sorry when you hurt someone and find ways to make it right. When someone has hurt you, don't look for vengeance. Leave it up to God Almighty to pay back. Romans 12v19 says Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. I bless you with the ability to forgive quickly, to not let the sun go down on your anger. I bless you with the ability to not hold grudges but instead to love and release the offenses and pain. I bless you, with the ability to quickly give it to Jesus. Your mind is highly valued and must be protected from gossip and evil talking. Keep good friends Exhorter, those who do justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with God (Micah 6v8).

### **WORLD CHANGER**

23. Exhorter you are one who relates well to people, you understand people and know how to foster good relationships. You are not shy and can strike up a conversation easily with someone you have never met before. You love being around people and accept them for being themselves. You are able to speak to the heart of people, inspire them to dream big and then to go after their dreams. You too have an inborn desire to conquer and you are a great communicator, clever & creative. You are a history maker, quick to see opportunities and flexible. I bless you with power, love and a sound mind to think clearly, remain focused and to finish the assignments that God has placed on your life. You are loved, you are precious. A king, A priest of the Most High God, created in His image - His child.
